

Pacific Coast Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Supplement

.01 SEASON

A. See COA Article 13

B. Schedule

1. Conference play will be Wednesday and Friday. All conference games will begin either at 5:00 PM or 7:00 PM as mutually agreed upon by opponents, prior to the publication of the conference schedule. The court will be available for warm-up one hour prior to start time. If double headers are scheduled, start times are 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 pm.
2. The 2011 Women's Basketball schedule sets the initial rotation, home and away sequence of conference games. In each subsequent year, the last games of each round of the previous season rotate to the top of the round and home and away games will reverse.

C. Reporting of Scores

1. The home team shall report the final game score to the Union-Tribune.

.02 PLAYING RULES

B. Officials

1. The Conference Commissioner will appoint the official's assignor for the conference. The assignment secretary assigns officials to work all conference games.
2. Conference coaches will evaluate officials after each game, and submit all evaluations to the identified party within one week after the completion of the game.
3. Conference coaches at the pre-season conference basketball meeting will agree upon the pool of officials.
4. There shall be three officials.
5. In the absence of one official, the game will begin if both coaches agree. If both coaches do not agree, a 30-minute delay will be in effect, in order to find a replacement. If a third official is not found, the game will be re-scheduled.
6. Home team will provide timer, scorer and 30-second clock operator.
7. Home team will be responsible for payment of officials.
8. The conference sets the official's fee schedule.
9. Any college canceling a scheduled conference game must notify the commissioner, the college involved, and the officials.

C. Equipment

1. Teams playing at home in all conference games shall wear light colored uniforms. Teams playing away from home shall wear dark colored uniforms.
2. The CCCAA adopted ball will be the official conference ball.
3. The home team will supply a minimum of six (6) balls for the visiting team to warm-up.
4. The home team will provide a separate area with chalkboard/Whiteboard and supplies for the visiting team's pre-game and half time.
5. The home team will provide six (6) towels for the visiting bench.

.03 AWARDS

- a) Team
 - i) Conference Championship
 - ii) Individual awards to Conference Champion (15)

- b) Individual
 - i) Player of the Year (1)
 - ii) All-Conference Certificates (15)

- c) All Conference Team Selection

Selections will be made at the post season meeting following the last Conference game. Meeting site and time to be determined by the Conference Representative. Said representative will chair the meeting.

 - i) Each conference school must have a representative in attendance for that school's vote to be valid.

- d) The PCAC All-Conference team will consist of 15 players.
 - i) The conference champions will have the opportunity to nominate 5 players.
 - ii) The 2nd place team will have the opportunity nominate 4 players.
 - iii) The 3rd place through last place team will have the opportunity to nominate 3 players each.

- e) Coaches' nominations must be given to the conference representative by 3:00 pm Tuesday of the last week of conference competition.
 - i) The Conference representative will send nominations to the coaches who will vote and return their ballot to the Conference representative by midnight on the Friday before the meeting.

- f) Voting for the All-Conference team will be as follows:
 - i) Each school will have one (1) ballot. The vote will be an open vote with each coach allowed to vote for players from their own team.

 - ii) The voting will take place on a point system basis.
 - (1) Each coach will award 15 points to the player they regard as the best player in the conference.
 - (2) Each coach will then award 14 through 1 points in corresponding order to their next selections.
 - (3) The player receiving the highest point total will be the Most Valuable Player of the conference.
 - (a) If a tie exists, both players will receive a Co-Most Valuable Player award.
 - (b) If a tie exists for the last spot on the All-Conference team a re-vote involving the tied players will take place.
 - (4) The top vote getter will be the Player of the Year and the #1 All-State nominee. In the event of a tie for this designation, the coaches will re-vote to select between tied players. All-State nominees will be representative of PCC ranked order.

- g) Selection of the Coach of the Year
 - i) Nominations will be given at meeting and voted upon by placing vote on a piece of paper and tallied by Administrative representative. In event of a tie, Co-Coach of the year will be awarded.

.04 CHAMPIONSHIP / PLAYOFF DETERMINATION

- A. Co-Champions will be declared in case of ties.

- B. Two way tie for Championship/tie breaker format for play-offs
 - 1. Head to head competition in conference games.

1. Record against other three teams
 2. Won/Loss record against each team in descending order
 3. Non-Conference rating power index
 4. Win/Loss percentage of overall record
 5. Coin Toss

.05 CONFERENCE BASKETBALL COMMITTEE

- A. Conference Appointed Administrative Representative
1. Chair and preside at all meetings, non-voting.
 2. Work with the conference commissioner regarding officials, rule interpretation, protests and other matters.
 3. Review the Pacific Coast Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Supplement annually.
 4. Submit conference schedule to Commissioner.
- B. Membership consists of all current PCAC Women's Basketball Coaches
- C. Voting membership shall be one vote per college.
- D. CCCWBCA Executive Board Representative
1. Selected by a committee member volunteer, or by vote of the members.
 2. Represents the PCAC at the seeding meeting and the state coach's association executive board meetings and presents the finished order of Conference play, after the tie-breakers have been enforced, to the Southern California seeding meeting.
 3. Will serve for a two-year time period.
 4. Will give updated information to all PCAC Head Coaches at every PCAC coaches meeting.
 5. Responsible for disbursing information and receiving timely feedback from the CCCWBCA throughout the year, to all members. A consensus vote by the conference members deemed necessary on any feedback issues will be presented back to the CCCWBCA with accuracy and according to established deadlines.
 6. If the CCCWBCA representative is unable to attend a required state meeting, the PCAC committee will vote on a replacement.

7. CCCWBCA representative-elect will be selected at the post-conference meeting at the end of the 1st term of the current representative.
 8. CCCWBCA representative will serve as a mentor to the representative-elect in the 2nd year of the term.
- A. CCCWBCA All-State Representative Team Selection
1. Selected by a committee member volunteer, or by vote of the members
 2. Will serve for a three-year time period.
 3. Represent the PCAC and attend all state meetings
 4. Responsible for the faxing of signed copy of All-State nominees in PCAC ranked order.
- F. Supplement Revisions
1. The committee shall evaluate annually the Women's Basketball supplement.
 2. The committee can recommend changes to the conference by a majority vote of the members present at any meeting of the basketball committee.

D. CCCWBCA Executive Board Representative

1. Selected by a committee member volunteer, or by vote of the members.
2. Represents the PCC at the seeding meeting and the state coach's association executive board meetings and presents the finished order of Conference play, after the tie-breakers have been enforced, to the Southern California seeding meeting.
3. Will serve for a two-year time period.
4. Will give updated information to all PCC Head Coaches at every PCC coaches meeting.
5. Responsible for disbursing information and receiving timely feedback from the CCCWBCA throughout the year, to all members. A consensus vote by the conference members deemed necessary on any feedback issues will be presented back to the CCCWBCA with accuracy and according to established deadlines.
6. If the CCCWBCA representative is unable to attend a required state meeting, the PCC committee will vote on a replacement.
7. CCCWBCA representative-elect will be selected at the post-conference meeting at the end of the 1st term of the current representative.
8. CCCWBCA representative will serve as a mentor to the representative-elect in the 2nd year of the term.

E. CCCWBCA All-State Representative Team Selection

1. Selected by a committee member volunteer, or by vote of the members
2. Will serve for a three-year time period.
3. Represent the PCC and attend all state meetings
4. Responsible for the faxing of signed copy of All-State nominees in PCC ranked order.

F. **Supplement Revisions**

1. The committee shall evaluate annually the Women's Basketball supplement.
2. The committee can recommend changes to the conference by a majority vote of the members present at any meeting of the basketball committee.
